

PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

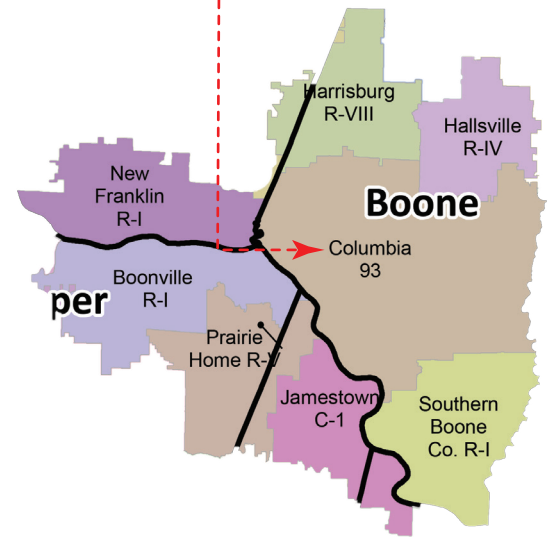

On April 5th, the Columbia School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 65 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$4.80 to \$5.45.

For a **\$100,000** house
that means \$123.50 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house
that means \$247 more per year in personal property taxes

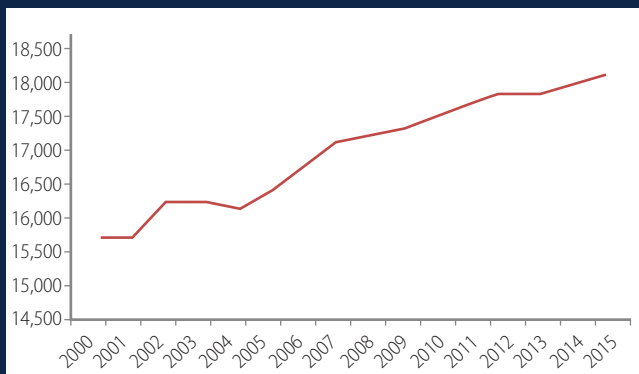
For a **\$250,000** house
that means \$308.75 more per year in personal property taxes
