

PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

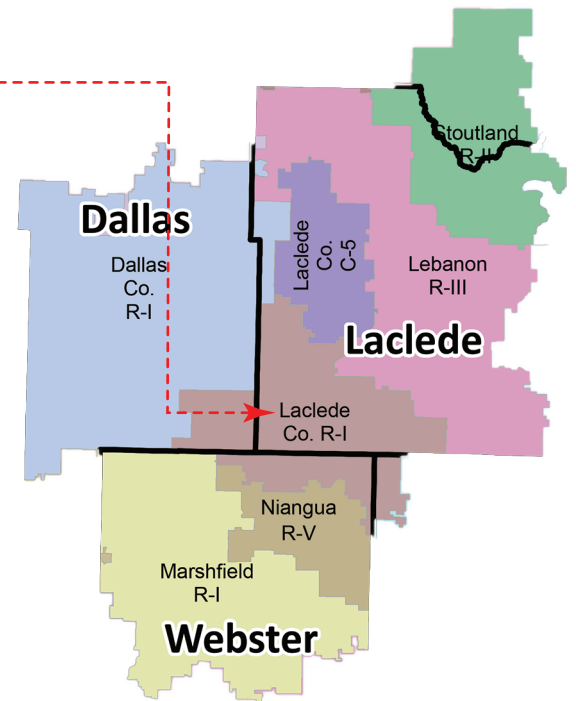
Laclede R-1

On April 5th, the Laclede School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 49 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$2.75 to \$3.24.

For a **\$100,000** house
that means \$93.10 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house
that means \$186.20 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house
that means \$232.75 more per year in personal property taxes

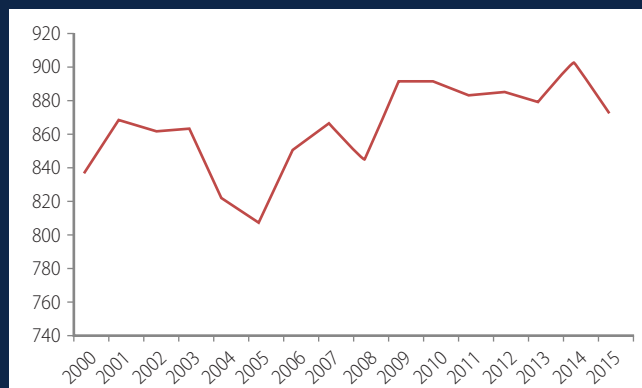
