

PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

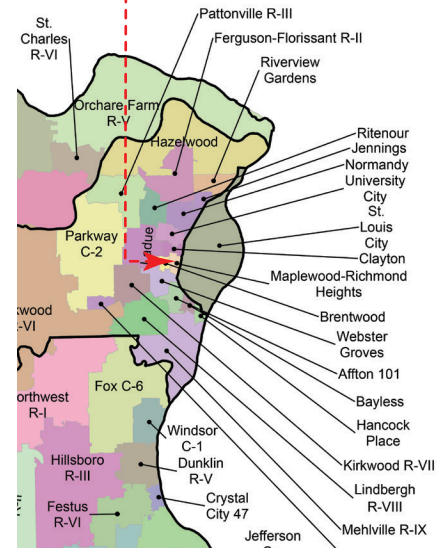
Maplewood-Richmond Heights

On April 5th, the Maplewood-Richmond Heights School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 50 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$4.42 to \$4.97.

For a **\$100,000** house
that means \$104.50 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house
that means \$209 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house
that means \$261.25 more per year in personal property taxes

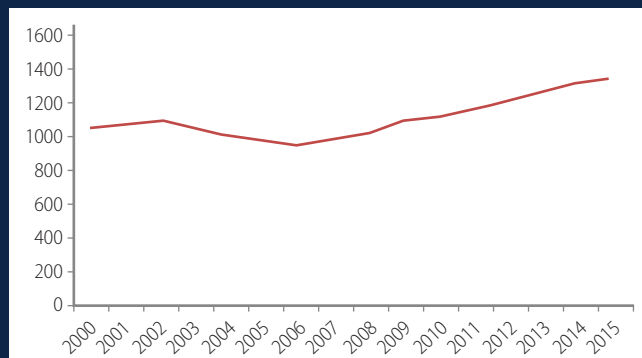
