

PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET


Marshfield R-1

On April 5th, the Marshfield school district is asking to raise the property tax levy by 50 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$2.75 to \$3.25.

For a **\$100,000** house
that means \$95 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house
that means \$190 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house
that means \$237.50 more per year in personal property taxes


