The MOCAP enrollment process may take several weeks to complete.

MOCAP 101

Missouri public school students can apply for a virtual education program called Missouri Course Access Program

- MOCAP is available for K-12 students
- Parents can choose from 10 different education providers
- Students can take all, or just some, of their courses online

MOCAP MAY WORK FOR YOU IF:

- You don't feel safe sending your child back to the classroom because of COVID-19.
- Your child, or someone in your household, has a health condition that makes catching or spreading COVID-19 especially worrisome.
- You are dissatisfied with how your district handled remote learning and would like to prepare your children with a quality online education should schools have to go remote again.
- You believe that an online education fits your child's learning needs better or provides access to a broader range of classes.
