

# PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

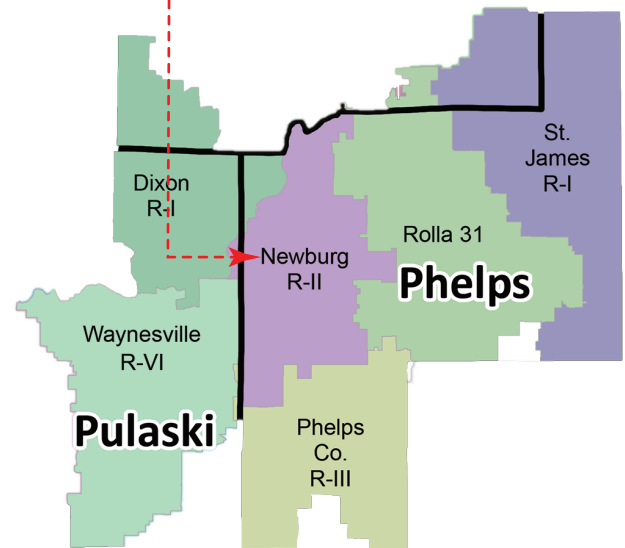
## Newburg R-II

On April 5th, the Newburg School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 96 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$2.75 to \$3.71.

For a **\$100,000** house  
that means \$182.40 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house  
that means \$264.80 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house  
that means \$456 more per year in personal property taxes
