

PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

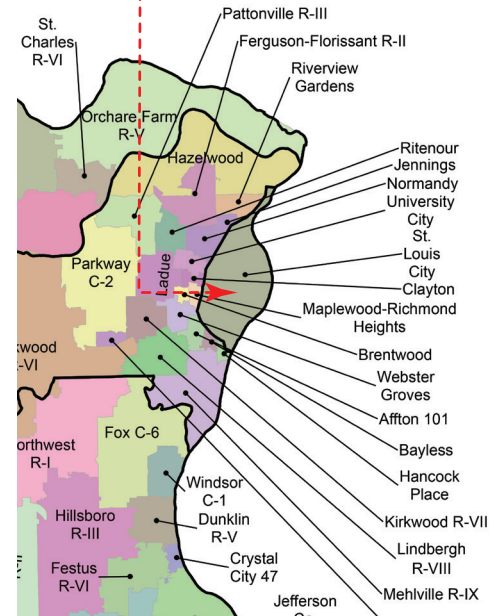
St. Louis City

On April 5th, the Saint Louis City School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 75 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$3.75 to \$4.50.

For a **\$100,000** house
that means \$142.50 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house
that means \$285 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house
that means \$356.25 more per year in personal property taxes

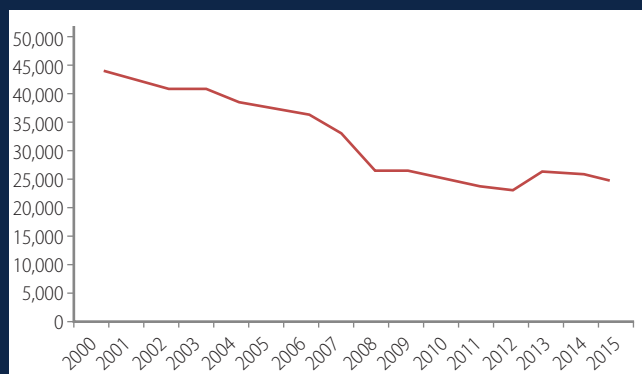
