

# PROPOSED TAX INCREASE INFORMATION SHEET

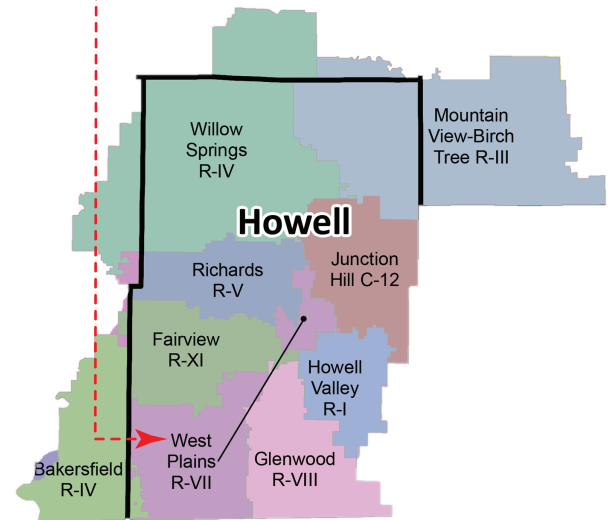
## West Plains R-VII

On April 5th, the West Plains School District is asking to raise the property tax levy by 95 cents per \$100 in assessed value. This will raise the levy from \$3.64 to \$4.59.

For a **\$100,000** house  
that means \$180.50 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$200,000** house  
that means \$361 more per year in personal property taxes

For a **\$250,000** house  
that means \$451.25 more per year in personal property taxes

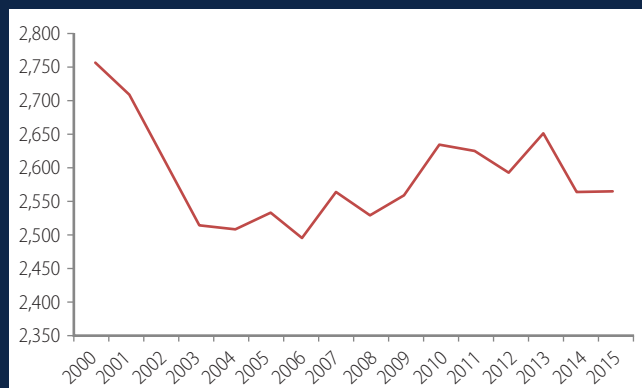
